Sir,

With reference to your letter No. MSS/920/75/ dated 25-4-75 on the subject mentioned above, I am to inform you that the Director of Education, Delhi has been pleased to extend the provisional recognition of Middle Department (from Classes VI to VIII) as unaided for one year w.e.f. 1-5-1975 to 30-4-1976 on the following conditions :-


1. Qualified staff may be appointed where-ever the posts are still lying vacant.
2. Qualified librarian should be appointed.
3. Pay and other emoluments of the teachers should not be less than those being paid in Govt. and Govt. aided Hr. Sec. Schools.
4. More equipment, furniture, apparatus, library books should be purchased.
5. The school premises shall not be utilised for commercial, residential, communal, political or non-educational activities of any kind what so-ever.
6. The school shall follow the approved course of instructions and syllabus prescribed by the appropriate authority from time to time. The admission will be opened to all irrespective of caste and creed.
7. The appointment of the staff will be made in accordance with the instructions contained in rules 96&97 of Delhi Education Rules, 1973 and other circulars issued by the Department in this respect from time to time.
8. *Principal* The school shall not run un-recognised classes in Nursery/primary Department in its premises.

9. The school shall have adequate facilities for accommodation, playground, library service, laboratory work, workshop practice and co-curricular activities.
10. The school should always maintain proper sanitary arrangements and provide clean drinking water to the students.
11. The school will maintain service agreement forms and service books in respect of each employee.
12. The school shall provide facilities for the pensionary benefits to its employees as per other option given under the Act.
13. The service of any employee shall not be terminated without the prior approval of D.E.
14. The school shall maintain all record which shall be open to inspection by any office authorised by the Director of Education or the appropriate authority at any time as provided under rules 50.
15. The school shall comply with the provisions of the Educational Act 1972/Rules and the ~~infarx~~ instructions issued by the Department from time to time.
16. The school accounts should be separated from the pupil's fund account. The school account will be jointly operated by the Manager and the Principal of the school whereas the pupil's fund will be operated by the Principal of the school.

Sir/Madam,

It has been the practice to grant recognition to schools for a limited period and such recognition used to lapse on the expiry of that period unless such recognition was renewed before the expiry of the period. This practice was based on rule 54(2) of the Delhi School Education Rules 1978. In civil writ No. 888 of 1977 in the case of Digambar Jain Society, the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi delivered a judgement on 30-8-1979 holding rule 54(2) ultra vires of the Delhi School Education Act, 1973. The operational portion of the said judgement reads here as under:


"Thus on a very careful consideration of all the various provisions of the Act and Rules, I am of the opinion that Rule 54(2) is ultra vires of the Act, and that recognition originally granted to the school was on absolute recognition at any rate, the recognition granted after 31-12-78 must be treated as the absolute grant of recognition within the scope of Rule 54. It must be deemed that the authority was satisfied that at some time the school will be able to fulfil the requirements and condition for grant of recognition and because of this satisfaction a provisional exemption was given to it and the school was recognised. This being so, the recognition and because of this satisfaction a provisional exemption was given to it and the school was recognised. This being so, the recognition cannot be taken away from the school except on the manner contemplated by Section 4 Sub-Section (4) or (6)".

The Prescribed Authority (Administrator of Delhi-Lt. Governor) announced his judgement on 9-11-79 in the case of Appeal No. 143/79-C.A. in the case of Bahar Education Trust Vs. State as here under:

"In view of the law laid down by the Delhi High Court in the case of Digambar Jain Society, it has been held, and I hold accordingly that the appellant school continued to be recognised school. In case the Director of Education is of the opinion that the school does not satisfy any one of the condition specified under sub-section (1) of Section 4, he will have to follow the procedure laid down under section (6) of section (4) read with rule 56."

In view of the above cited High Court Judgement and above quoted Pronouncement of the Prescribed Authority (Lt. Governor), recognition of no school shall lapse as specified under rule 54(2). Recognition once granted shall be absolute.

Hence no school will be deemed recognised for a limited period, no matter whether it was recognised prior to the commencement of the Act/Rules, 1978 or has been granted recognition thereafter. Henceforth all recognised schools shall be deemed to be permanently recognised and recognition could be withdrawn only through the procedure laid down under sub-sec.(6) of Section (4) of the Act read with Rule 56 of Delhi, School Education Rules, 1978.

The School Managements are requested to ensure that statutory requirements governing recognition as laid down under Section 4(1) (a) to (f) of the Delhi Education Act, 1978 should be duly complied with and conditions prescribed under rule 50 of the Delhi School Education Rules, 1978 should be duly fulfilled as well as facilities specified under Rule 51 under the said rule should be duly provided to the School. Conditions already imposed governing recognition should be fulfilled and report thereof be submit to the undersigned through Zonal Education Officer. The Managements will also continue to comply with other relevant requirements of the Delhi School Education Act and Rules 1978 as applicable to their schools.

The District Deputy Directors and Zonal Education Officers are required to conduct through inspection from time to time on the information/ / of the above mentioned statutory requirements/conditions of recognition and keep a record thereof in the recognition files. Deficiencies, if any, be pointed out to the Managements for removing the same within specified period under intimation to the undersigned. In case, any Management fails to fulfil the statutory requirements mentioned above, action should be taken for withdrawal of recognition of in accordance with the procedure laid down under sub-section (6) of Sec.4 of the Act read with Rule 56 of Delhi School Education Rules, 1978.


1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act, 1973 and rules framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued by the Department from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed.
3. That the school shall appoint full time qualified and eligible staff for classes from I to XII.
4. That the school shall equip the Science Labs as per the norms of the Department and suitable facilities may be provided.
5. That proper Library shall be established and books as per the ratio of 10 books per student shall be provided. Separate facility of reading room for students and teachers may be provided.
6. That adequate sports facilities for indoor as well as outdoor games may be provided.
7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provision of Sec.10(i) of Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973.
8. That the enrolment in section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 sq.ft. per student for the available floor area of the classroom and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Department in each class. Number of sections should not exceed the number of existing classrooms of proper size in the school.

9. That the school shall not run any unrecognized or any other activities in the school premises. All the recognised classes shall be run at one place. Nursery class be removed from the premises of the school.
10. That the school shall discontinue with the services of unqualified and overaged staff, if any, immediately.
11. That the scheme of management shall be got approved from the Department immediately.
12. That the service contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
13. That all the facilities prescribed under Rule 50 & 51 of the DCEA & Rules, 1973 shall be made available to the students.
14. That the provision of Rules 6, 7, 8 & 9 shall be observed strictly.
15. That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be provided to the students as well as teachers. And proper sanitation may be made and Health Certificate from the competent authority may be obtained.
16. That the management of the school shall create a reserve fund of Rs.15,000 (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) in the name of the Director of Education and the Manager of the school in any Scheduled Bank.
17. That the management of the school shall immediately apply for the affiliation of the school with the Secretary, CBSE through the Education Officer concerned.
18. That the violation of any instructions/orders/conditions rules and regulations of the Department shall lead to the withdrawal of the school's recognition.
19. That the report about the fulfilment of the above conditions giving the extent to which each condition is fulfilled shall be sent to the Education Officer every six month and information under Rule 160 may be furnished to the DDE(Act). That the school shall have to fulfil all the conditions laid down earlier while granting recognition from class VI to XII.
