



In the post-pandemic period, Ms. Bhatnagar identified the growing issue of reduced student enthusiasm for physical schooling, which contributed to the rise of 'dummy schools.' To address this, she introduced regular counseling sessions to reignite students' interest, emotional well-being, and engagement in meaningful learning.

Understanding the evolving language and cultural dynamics of newer generations — from Millennials to Gen Z, Gen Alpha, and now Gen Beta — Ms. Bhatnagar remains committed to adapting to these shifts. Despite the challenges posed by regulations and policies, she continues to stay proactive, consistently seeking opportunities to enhance learning outcomes and provide students with enriching educational experiences.


On a Personal Note

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





This initiative aimed to instill compassion and social responsibility among the students while making a meaningful difference in the lives of those in need.



Teacher's Workshop On ALLERGY AWARENESS PROGRAM







Manav Sthali School, R block won two positions in the National Level.


Hiteshi of class IX secured 16th rank in B1.1 Level.






