



"If you nurture the root, you don't have to bother about the fruit, it will come naturally."

With this quote Manav Sthali School International Primary Curriculum celebrated their Exit Point of all 3 Mileposts with great zeal and enthusiasm, under the guidance of our Principal Mrs Dipti A. Bhatnagar.

Exit Points are the final step in the students' learning journey. During a Unit of Study on Plants, their growth and their importance, the children showcased their learning on the 8th and 9th of August, 2024 at the International Primary Curriculum Wing of the School.

The children were thrilled and delighted to perform and celebrate their learning in the presence of Principal Mrs .Dipti A Bhatnagar, Mrs. Rashmi Chawla, Coordinator for ISSE Programme, Mexican Delegates and the Parents.

Children of Grades 1 and 2, under Milepost 1 'Green Fingers' sang beautiful songs on the parts and needs of a plant to grow well. They also demonstrated with an action song on how a plant grows explaining the process of photosynthesis. Parents were amazed to see their kids perform with confidence and enjoyment.

For Milepost 2 – (Grades 3 and 4), Children showcased their learning by enacting themselves as different parts of the plants, explaining their functions elaborately. They also sang and danced on the food chain song depicting the dependency and importance of producers and primary and secondary consumers in our ecosystem.

For Milepost 3, the Unit was Roots, Shoots and Fruits, wherein the children demonstrated their learning and research work by conducting an experiment on how the vascular tissues inside the plants supply them food, water and minerals. They also apprised the parents of the function of leaves and how one can differentiate or recognize the plants having tap root or fibrous root just by looking at the leaves.

Parents thoroughly enjoyed the performances.

Through this Unit of Work; our children learnt about three personal goals of International Primary Curriculum namely Respect, Adaptability and Resistance.
